

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FENTON, MISSOURI, EXPRESSING THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN'S DESIRE TO NOT SELL ITS PROPERTY LOCATED AT 900 GREGORY LANE AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO REJECT ANY SUCH PURCHASE OFFER.

WHEREAS, the City of Fenton owns the property located at 900 Gregory Lane, commonly referred to by City staff as the old cop shop; and

WHEREAS, from time to time, the City receives inquiries from various persons and corporations expressing an interest in purchasing such property from the City; and

WHEREAS, at this time, due to various reasons including the historical value and unique nature of the property to the City and its connection to other City property, the Board of Aldermen has no interest in selling such property and would like to enact this resolution to inform the general public of the same and that until such time that this resolution is repealed, the Board of Aldermen will not entertain an offer to purchase said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FENTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Fenton hereby declare to the general public that the City has no interest at this time in selling its property located at 900 Gregory Lane and until such time that a majority of the Board of Aldermen repeal this resolution, staff is instructed and authorized to reject any offer received for purchasing such property with or without notice to the Board of Aldermen.
